

# **Development issues in Downer**

The DCA has been involved in a number of issues regarding development in Downer, including the following:

- a submission on the Development Application for 90 & 92 Blacket St, highlighting several items which did not comply with planning laws. ACTPLA has since refused the DA, and the developer is considering whether to make changes
- a submission on the proposed light rail connection from Gungahlin to the City. DCA suggested Government should be looking at Downer in an integrated way – community needs, development, transport and infrastructure. An example of an inconsistent approach is high density development on the old school site when the main transport corridor will be along Northbourne Ave, 1 km away. Also noted was the lack of stops for light rail in Downer.
- a submission on the proposed demolition of the old Downer School buildings (imminent).
   Issues raised were:
  - demolition before clear plans of the proposed development had been presented to local residents and approved by ACTPLA
  - concern over the time a bare site would remain before construction
  - effects of noise, dust and traffic on nearby residents
  - preservation of the old school courtyard
  - protection of trees
- The long-running saga of redevelopment of the old Downer School site. In November and December, DCA asked for comments on this issue from Downer residents.
   Several people responded, with the following issues consistently being raised:
  - o Parking/increased traffic flow
  - Preference for retirement village/townhouse development
  - Community good should be a priority, not just Government profit
  - Part of the site to be retained for community use (e.g. childcare)
  - Development should be compatible with redevelopment of the shops

Early this year, a DCA delegation met with representatives from the Chief Minister's office to discuss many of these issues. No clear outcomes came from this meeting, but Government expressed interest in the views of residents collected in the above survey.

### **Downer Shops update**

Despite ACTPLA approval and assurances from the developer, work has still not commenced on the site. The developer continues to seek tenants for the various shops, obviously preferring to defer on-site work until leases are signed. The DCA will continue to talk to the developer to encourage progress. As noted in an earlier Newsletter, the expected order of work will be:

- removal of asbestos roofing and replacement with other materials
- cleaning exterior to original brickwork
- extending rear service courts
- addition of basements and new floor
- partition into retail space
- addition of new timber pergolas
- provision of external water tank
- reconfiguration of existing carpark.
