Re: Downer 50Th Birthday Celebrations on Saturday 27 March 2010

Downer was gazetted as a suburb on 7 April 1960 with the first building and construction commencing soon after that date. The suburb is named after Sir John Downer, Premier of South Australia and a member of the first Senate and significant contributor to the Federation of the Australian states.

To commemorate the occasion the Downer community is holding the Downer 50^{Th} Birthday Celebration day on Saturday 27 March 2010. This will be at the Downer Community Centre and surrounding area (Downer Oval). The ACT Government through a grant from the ACT Heritage Fund has provided substantial funding to run the day. The focus will be on a community celebration and the preparation of commemorative material.

A community working group has been formed to manage the anniversary celebrations. If you would like to be part of this you will be made to feel very welcome. Even if you just want to help with one aspect of the preparation for the day just contact Di on 62411372 or see Sue at the Community Centre office (62496443).

The day will see the unveiling of the Downer Heritage Walk; the launch of a book and CD of Downer's past and the unveiling of a mural commemorating the CSIRO poppy fields that used to be onsite. Significant progress is already being made with the celebrations. We are talking to CSIRO about their history in Downer; seeking out former Downer Primary School teachers and talking to the ABC about a segment on Stateline.

On the day there will be lots of entertainment for both young and old; stalls, art and craft exhibitions by our centre users and plenty of good food to be had. Yet another highlight of the day will be an art exhibition for our young residents. Details of the subject, competition rules and prizes will be in our next newsletter
