Update on Downer Former School Site and Shops

Progress continues to be made on getting some action on the Downer Centre area. The Chief Minister has written to the DCA stating that the Downer local centre is an issue that requires decisive action in 2011. A reference group including community representatives is to be established to work in partnership with Government to decide on the future of the site without further delay.

Proposed is redevelopment of the Former School Site for mixed residential and community uses. This would include some medium density and community housing. Other uses such aged care facilities and a childcare centre are also being considered. The former shops would become a community facility.

On this issue the Canberra Times 11 March reported The ACT Government is understood to be considering two sites, in Dickson and Downer, for the development of affordable rental accommodation for low-income earners. Several community organisations are interested in investing in the development, which could be eligible for funds under the National Rental Affordability Scheme. The ACT Department of Land and Property Services chief executive David Dawes said the affordable housing proposal was at an early stage but it was hoped that building could begin within 18 months.

If you want make your views heard on this issue a working group of the DCA is meeting monthly every second Thursday at 7:30pm at the centre.

DOWNER TAX HELP CENTRE

Later this year qualified volunteers will be available at the Downer Centre to assist people on low incomes with basic tax returns.

Tax payers with no dependent children and on incomes below \$40,000 will be eligible for free assistance. The threshold rises if they have dependent children. The Tax Help volunteers are not able to assist those with more complex tax affairs such as income from business, investment properties etc.

Clean Up Day in Downer Report

"Clean Up Australia Day 2011" in Downer

On Sunday 6 March, 25 volunteers turned up at the Downer Community Centre to pick up bags and gloves and walk the parks and lanes of Downer picking up trash and recycling. 8 of those volunteers were under 18 years of age.

They collected 12 bags of rubbish, 9 bags of recycling, 3 TV's, 1 cubic metre (approx) of cardboard, a pile of wood pieces, misc scrap metal, an air conditioner, a vacuum cleaner, and a wheelie bin (recycling) w/o wheels. They also identified areas with broken glass which were later reported to Canberra Connect (and cleaned up!!)

Jim (with the trailer) was a great help again this year, rounding up those bigger items. Next year we could use more rubbish bags relative to recycling. We had to empty half-filled bags in order to give new volunteers something to collect into. Thanks to all who participated!!
